03 tons gross of London, for the purpose of issuing a Provisional Free-
board Certificate pending the issuance of an International Load Line
Certificate from this Society.

The freeboards assigned by the American Bureau of Shipping have
been marked on the vessel's sides and verified.

The survey for the freeboard assignment has been made and this
certificate is valid until the official certificate is issued, or for a
period not exceeding six months.

In my opinion the vessel may safely sail under the present free-
boards, which are as follows:-

Center of disc below top of steel upper deck	6' - 5"
Tropical above center of disc	5 1/4"
Fresh water above center of disc	6 1/2"
Tropical fresh above center of disc	11 3/4"
Winter below center of disc	5 1/4"
