We request that the Committee of Lloyd's Register will instruct the Society's Surveyors to Specially Survey during Construction the Hull, Engines and Boilers of the Vessel No. 192 building by Messrs. Kockums Mek. Verkstad A.B. for Messrs. A/S HAVMÖY & P. Meyer, Oslo of 9800 Tons. Length 490'-0" Breadth 62'-9", Depth 36'-7" intended to be Classed * 100A1 "Carrying petroleum in bulk"

We undertake to arrange for every facility to be given to the Surveyors to carry out the duty in question, and we agree to pay the fees for the Surveyors' services, in addition to the actual travelling and other expenses incurred by the Surveyors in connection therewith.

This request is made upon the terms of the Rules and Regulations of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, which provide that:—
