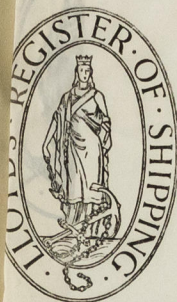

*Surveyed the "ARABIAN PRINCE" 2000tons gross of London as she lay at No. 7 Dock Manchester on account of Damage stated caused when lifting anchor in Inner Harbour at Latakia on 7th December, 1958, it was found that the starboard anchor was missing, and that I have transmitted to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a Report stating that all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, and that I have Recommended that she be continued as classed without record of survey,*

*being fit to carry her usual cargoes.*
