"HAUKEFJELL" I attach for your information a copy of the classing letter which has today been addressed to the Kiel Surveyor respecting the surveys carried out at that port last year. Classification Certificates are enclosed herewith for transmission to the Owners.

In reply to your letter of the 11th ultimo I shall be glad if you will inform Messrs. Olsen, Ugelstad that where an old engine is removed from one ship and refitted in another, such an engine is considered for class on its condition etc. as found at the time of refitting and, if accepted for class, will be recorded in the Register Book with its date of build and date of refitting. The effective age of an engine in terms of running hours is not a matter with which the Society is directly concerned or about which the Society could supply a statement for the use of the Insurers.

In the case of the above vessel the engine will be entered in the Register Book as stated on the attached classing letter.
