The Surveyor reports some damage sustained to the starboard outboard auxiliary engine and this engine now out of commission pending repairs. The Surveyor recommends that the class be made subject to the starboard outboard auxiliary engine crankcase being examined and dealt with by the end of May, 1960, meantime the remaining auxiliary engines considered to be sufficient for essential sea services.
