
S. With reference to your letter of the 29th ultimo respecting the Steamer "BALTKON", I have to acquaint you that the report of the survey terminated at Cardiff on the 25th March last has today come to hand.

The Surveyors state that in their opinion the vessel is eligible to be classed "100A1" with fresh Docking Date 3,48 and notation of S.S.Cff.-3,48 subject to a stream anchor of Rule weight being supplied, also to cargo battens being supplied at the first convenient opportunity.

As regards the machinery, a notation of LMC 3,48 is recommended subject to the starboard boiler shell plate in way of blowdown valve being specially examined at the next Boiler Survey. A record of SN 12,47 C.L. is recommended relative to the Screwshaft Survey.
