

Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in

Alterations consequent on Additional Accommodation
for Crew being provided in Poop and Forecastle Spaces.



The following alterations have been made:-

POOP DECK:- Two steel companionways 7'-0" x 3' -2" of strong construction fitted on Poop Deck giving access to new accommodation with hinged steel doors operated from both sides and rubber jointed. The doors are 5'-0" x 2'-0" and close with six clips having sills 16" high. Four hatchways 2'-11" x 2'-11" giving access to Poop Space have been dispensed with and deck openings satisfactorily plated over. Part wood deck on Poop Deck over accommodation has been extended over the additional accommodation. Two additional ventilators have been fitted giving access to Poop Space, 8" diameter and coamings 30" x .30, and closing appliances fitted. ✓

POOP SPACE:- Additional side scuttles have been fitted port and starboard with strong hinged deadlights. Two additional W.C. discharges have been fitted discharging below freeboard deck with brass storm valves at ship's sides. ✓

FORECASTLE SPACE:- The forecastle accommodation has been re-arranged as shown, and additionally sidelights with strong deadlights have been fitted. The original stairway openings to lower forecastle have been satisfactorily
