m.s. "Berny" ex "Bergo"

The above motorvessel which sunk last year has been salvaged by us and renamed "Berny". The vessel is now here in Mariehamn and we are building new accommodations and doing all other repairs which can be done without dry-docking. The bottom is also damaged and as soon as we have finished here the vessel will be drydocked elsewhere for final repairs.

In connection with the bottom repairs we intend to extend the vessel's length by cutting it off by frame 49 and building in 6 new frames. The length over all will then be 59,5 m. instead of 56.25 m. We enclose 3 drawings showing how we intend to do the work. We ask you kindly to show the drawings for Lloyds in order to find out if they can agree to our proposals. Should it not comply with their rules please ask them to let us know what amendments they require. As soon as we know their reply we shall make out definite drawings and send them necessary copies. This is only a preliminary request in order to learn Lloyds opinion in shortest possible time.
