to Messrs. M. Wain & Son, Sunderland to-day.

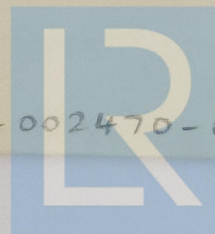
The Main Engines and boilers were examined under
