The remarks contained in your letter of the 23rd instant are noted and have been read to the Committee. They naturally appreciate the difficulties with which the Owners are at present faced in connection with this vessel and in order to assist, as far as practicable, they are prepared to agree to maintenance of class until the ship arrives at Piraeus direct from Suez, provided such voyage is undertaken within a reasonable time.

The Owners will doubtless appreciate that in view of the year of grace having expired last March, the Committee would not be justified in further maintaining class for a long period and the Committee have, therefore, given instructions for the case to be reviewed within a month by which time they hope that you will have been able to make satisfactory arrangements for the ship to proceed to Piraeus where the overdue survey must receive attention on arrival.

If a Load Line Certificate is desired it will be necessary for a Load Line Survey to be held before the ship leaves Suez for Piraeus.

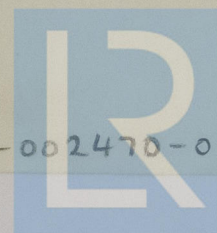
