I acknowledge the receipt of your letter of yesterday's date and have today informed the Committee of your statement that the vessel should arrive in Piraeus by 8th instant.

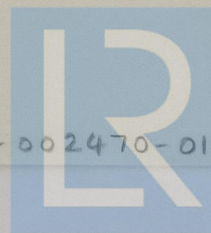
