The case has now been before the Committee who have given instructions for the notation "To be broken up" to be entered against the vessel's name in the Register Book.

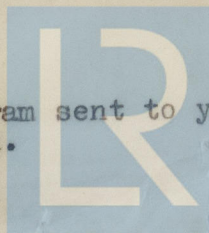
