I acknowledge your letter of the 4th September and note that this ship has been sold.

There will be no objection to the ship proceeding with a cargo of scrap to Hong Kong and thence to a port in China for breaking up, provided that on completion of discharge of the present cargo at Liverpool about the 12th September, the ship be generally inspected and found or placed in a satisfactory condition for the proposed voyage. The question of drydocking is left to the discretion of the Society's Surveyors at Liverpool.
