Mr. A. Burrows, superintendent for the above Owners, called at this Office recently and stated that it was proposed to replace the wing boilers in the above vessel by two boilers which had been constructed by Messrs. Cammell Laird & Co.Ltd., to the order of the Admiralty and originally intended for Trawlers.

These boilers, Nos. 2259 and 2264 were constructed under survey, Liverpool Reports Nos. 120674 and 121374, and are now being installed in the vessel at Liverpool. Mr. Burrows enquired what working pressure could be accepted for these boilers, and it appears from the calculations made in this Office that this should be 200 lb. per sq. inch as originally approved.

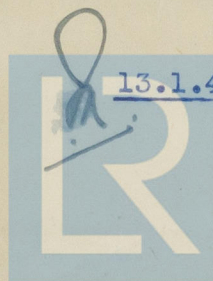
IT IS SUBMITTED that Messrs. Houlder Bros. be informed with reference to Mr. Burrows' recent visit that as desired by him the plan of the replace boilers for the above vessel has been examined and it is considered that the working pressure should not exceed 200 lbs. per sq. inch as originally approved and the Liverpool Surveyors are being advised accordingly.
