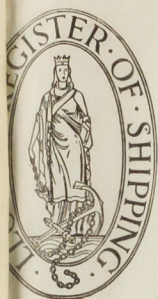


## LLOYD'S REGISTER OF SHIPPING

the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of

the Owners' Representatives attend on board the s.s. "BADARPUR", 8122 tons gross of London, on the 21st August 1957 and subsequently for the purpose of ascertaining the nature and extent of damage stated due to the vessel grounding in the Shatt-el-Arab on the 14th August 1957 while on a voyage from Abadan to Karachi.

For further particulars see log-books.

As it was not practicable to examine the tanks internally a diver was employed and a copy of his report is attached.

All bilges and double bottom tanks were sounded with no pumping operations between soundings and no increase was noted. The steering gear was examined and tested and found in good order and the stern frame, rudder and stock were examined as far as practicable and found in good order.

The main condenser and circulating system was examined and found clean and the pumping arrangements were tested and found satisfactory.

In view of the foregoing the only recommendation made is that the underwater parts of the vessel be specially examined at the next drydocking and any damage which may be disclosed and can be attributed to the alleged grounding is to be dealt with as may be required.
