EXAMINATION AND REPAIRS AS PER RULE FOR DAMAGE

Damage stated to have been caused by Heavy Weather during voyage, Antwerp to Genoa, between the 3rd and 16th Dec., 1960

DAMAGE REPAIRS:- Plates numbered from aft.

Shell plate L10 Port side fractured, cropped and part renewed.

Shell plate G12 Starboard side fractured, fracture veed out and welded.

It was recommended that this plate be specially examined and dealt with at next Special Survey.

Shell plate E5 Starboard side fracture. Now fitted efficient cement box; it was recommended this plate be specially examined and dealt with at Rotterdam, to which port she is proceeding via Barcellona.

NOTE:- It was stated by the Owners Representative that the vessel will probably be sold for demolition, on arrival at Rotterdam.

GENERAL OBSERVATIONS, OPINION AND RECOMMENDATION AS TO CLASS

State clearly what alteration, if any, is suggested to be made in the existing Classification or Survey or other records of the Ship in the Register Book consequent upon this survey; for example:—"to remain as Classed in the Register Book without fresh record of Docking"; "to remain as Classed and to have record of drydocking 1,55"; or "to remain as Classed and to have record of drydocking 1,55, and the notation of S.S. . . . 1,55".

This ship, so far as now surveyed, is eligible, in my opinion, to remain as now classed, without fresh record, subject to fractured and welded shell plate G.12 Starboard side from aft. being examined and dealt with, at the next Special Survey, and to fractured shell plate E5 Starboard side from aft. being dealt with, at Rotterdam to which port she is proceeding, Via Barcellona, and to all other outstanding conditions.
