ACTION and NOTATION of 'ss. Adl. 11,50' are DEFERRED for completion of Special Survey due 5,50.

TO COMPLETE S.S.:- Repairs are required to the windlass which has thereafter to be fitted on board.

In the meantime arrangements are made for the chain cable to be worked by the trawl winch, pending the re-fitting of the windlass, which ~~was~~ arranged for (11,50) to be dealt with on ship's return to the base port i.e. Albany.

According to a letter dated 28.12.51 from the Fremantle Surveyor, the windlass repairs have been effected and examined by him, and the windlass sent to Albany for installation.

The year of grace expired 5,51 and the windlass still remains to be fitted on board.

According to a report dated 2,51 from the Fremantle Surveyor of a fire damage, examination of the underwater part of the ship is recommended at the next drydocking, and this still remains to be carried out.

A cablegram has now been received from the Fremantle Surveyor advising that the Owners desire two more fishing trips (i.e. two months duration) further postponement to keep ship earning until Government decision reached regarding future finance. It would appear from this that the drydocking in January last, anticipated by the Fremantle Surveyor in his letter dated 28.12.51, has therefore been cancelled.

The case is submitted for the consideration of the Committee.
