M.S. "BRITISH TRADITION"

With reference to my letter of the 7th May, 1959 and previous correspondence, it is concluded that the ship is still laid up at Portland but your confirmation on this point would be appreciated.

I take this opportunity to remind you that following the commencement of the Auxiliary Boiler Survey at Portland in November last, the class is at present continued subject to the defective boiler tubes in the port boiler being renewed by the completion of the survey and before the ship is re-commissioned. The safety valves remain to be adjusted and the remote controls and oil burning equipment also require to be examined to complete this Auxiliary Boiler Survey.
