X centre The Surveyors should be informed it is concluded the depth of the girder, the thicknesses of the centre and side girder plating and the scantlings of the centre girder bottom angles in the double bottom tank under the machinery space, the thicknesses of the second deck strutting plating and deck plating forward and aft are in accordance with the approved plans and not as reported, that there are 16 bulkheads extending to the upper deck, that the dimensions of the hatchway at the fore hold are in accordance with the freeboard report and that the diameter of the joining shackle of the chain cables as reported is in error, but they should state if this is so. They should also be referred to Circular 1551 and informed it appears that the correct length of the bridge for record in the Register Book is 47'.
