In answer to numerous enquiries regarding completion of the above survey the Owners in a letter dated 1.12.58 stated it had been decided not to complete the Special Survey, and that the ship would be tied up.

The BELFAST Surveyors report this ship examined afloat prior to being towed to Preston at which port she is to be broken up.
