have been Specially Surveyed by the Surveyors to this Society during construction at Elsinore & Gothenburg and were reported to be on the 14th November 1946 at Stockholm in good, efficient, and safe working condition, at a pressure of 220 lb. per square inch on the main boilers. The approved working pressure of the donkey boiler is 5 lb. per square inch.

The Record LMC 1146 (Lloyd's Machinery Certificate) has been made in the Register Book, subject to Periodical Surveys as required by the Rules, & to an isolating switch being fitted to windlass motor at the first opportunity.


