Reverting to my letter of the 11th April, a report of survey carried out during May last has been received from the Society's Surveyors at Cardiff, from which it is noted that this vessel was generally examined in drydock with satisfactory results, the Special Survey of the machinery partly held and the Main Boiler Survey dealt with.

In the circumstances, the Committee have agreed to the Special Survey being postponed until the end of June next year, and have assigned fresh records of docking 5,57, Main Boiler Survey 5,57.

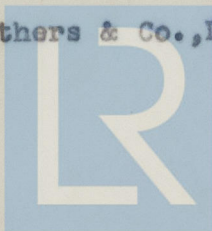
As previously recommended, this vessel's class is subject to shell plates D.3 and 4, E. 4 (starboard side forward) and E.3 and 4, F.3 (port side forward) being examined and dealt with as necessary by the next Special Survey.
