The dynamo is of the Makers D.C. type No. MIOFK, 115 V., 122 amps. 650 R.P.M.

The following tests on the machine were witnessed with satisfactory results: -

- Temperature test under full load.
- Insulation resistance,
- High potential test.

Copy of the Makers' certificate covering the shop tests is attached.

The dynamo was further examined at rest and the materials and workmanship appear good.
