It is submitted that the vessel is eligible for the RECORD, since 542, 12.42 CL. 12.42 854 NHP 560. Engines made 22, fitted 26. The size of many of the electric cables are less than the Rules require, but the ones are probably clerical. The Surveyor should check the engine room and send a report.
