EXAMINATION AND REPAIRS AS PER RULE FOR GENERAL EXAMINATION FOR POSTPONEMENT OF SPECIAL SURVEY type C, Due 6,58 vessel 24 Years old.

NOW DONE FOR GENERAL EXAMINATION AND DOCKING SURVEY.

Vessel placed on slipway. Shell plating, sternframe and rudder cleaned and examined. Bottom recoated. Last seen on slipway 17/4/58.

Fish hold and bilges, main coal bunkers (coal removed), wing bunkers (as far as practicable) (partially filled with coal), structure under engines and boilers, fore peak tank, after peak tank, machinery spaces, casings, decks, hatchways, coamings, ventilators, closing appliances, steering gear, windlass and general equipment generally examined and found satisfactory.




