Motorship "BRITISH LANCER"

With reference to your letter of the 15th and my letter of the 18th October last, I have to advise you that the Society's Surveyors at Newcastle-on-Tyne have reported that a satisfactory General Examination in drydock has been carried out in September/December, 1956.

As a result of this inspection the Committee have agreed that the Special Survey may be postponed until the end of November, 1957.

The Continuous Survey cycle of the machinery was completed at this time together with the Donkey Boiler Survey and a record of drydocking 12,56, together with notations of SLMC CS 12,56 and Donkey Boiler Survey 12,56 have been assigned.

A Classification Certificate in respect of the Continuous Survey of the machinery is enclosed.
