As the result of a General Examination and part Special Survey held by the New Orleans Surveyors in November, 1957, the American Committee on the 29th January, 1958 approved postponement of the Special Survey until November, 1958.

To complete the Special Survey, all Rule requirements remain to be complied with except examination of rudder, fore and after peak tanks Nos. 2 and 4 double bottom tanks, anchors cables and chain locker. As regards the machinery, the following parts have been seen:-

MP top end bearings.
After LP slide valve.
Propeller and sea connections.
Forward and after feed pumps.
Electrical installations.

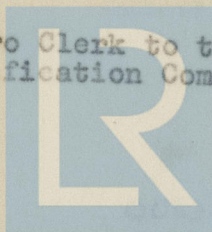
I shall be glad to learn what arrangements are now in hand for the survey to be completed and also for the Special RMC Survey to be held.
