Mr. Peacock telephoned from Liverpool this morning and stated that this ship is being sold for breaking up.

The intending purchasers are on board today and desire to know this afternoon the Society's minimum requirements for the issue of a certificate to proceed to a Continental port, probably Belgium, for breaking up, (a) under her own steam
(b) in tow.

Submitted Owners be informed that for condition (a) the ship should be generally examined afloat - and in dry dock too, if considered necessary by the Surveyors and found or placed in a satisfactory condition for the voyage proposed; for the condition (b) the foregoing requirements to be complied with and in addition, a note to be made on the Interim certificate indicating that the ship's class is suspended for the proposed voyage and towing arrangements are outwith the Society's jurisdiction. as unclassed ship.
