The Committee have had before them a report of survey held by the Society's Surveyors in London during March/June last, from which it is noted that new engines have been installed on board this vessel, a complete Special Survey of the remaining machinery and electrical equipment held, and a new screwshaft fitted. Notations of LMC 6,48, SNE 6,48 and SN 5,48 have accordingly been assigned.

The torsional vibration characteristics of the shafting installation of the machinery have been examined in this office and approved for a service speed of 330 R.P.M., provided a Notice Board be fitted at the control station, stating that the engine is not to be operated continuously between 232 and 269 R.P.M., and the engine tachometer marked accordingly. A classification certificate for the machinery is enclosed herewith, endorsed to this effect.
