

 and that I have transmitted to the Committee of Lloyd's
 Register of Shipping, London, a Report stating that all
 recommendations made by me in connection therewith have
 been carried out to my satisfaction, and that I have
 Recommended that the record of Main Boiler Survey 1,59

be made in the Register Book in the case of this vessel. , when the
 survey has been completed, subject to the propeller shaft being re-examined
 and dealt with as found necessary by the end of January 1960 (12 months
 limit) - To complete the Main Boiler Survey the port and starboard boilers
 to be examined throughout, the mountings of the centre boiler to be examined
 and all the safety valves to be adjusted under steam.
