Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines
in ✓

Bridge after bulkhead.

The opening on starboard side, which was closed with a riveted plate at Hull, England, in October 1942 now re-opened and fitted with a portable steel plate, $\frac{3}{8}$ " thick, secured by $\frac{1}{2}$ " steel studs. The original angles for stormboards retained at opening..

Two torpedo vents removed and welded plates fitted to bulkhead in way.

A companionway on bridge deck abaft the deeptank hatchway removed and the opening in deck plating closed with a $\frac{1}{2}$ " plate over one frame space, riveted and welded.

Two sanitary discharges from bridge 'tween deck blanked off by small welded plates on outside of shell plating.
