Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines
in 1932.

Additional accommodation for 10 gunners has been fitted on the starboard side at the after end of Bridge Tween deck space.

2-10" sidelights fitted in shell and 2-10" sidelights fitted in after bridge bulkhead, all with hinged deadlights.

Storm valve from W.C. discharges overboard above freeboard deck.

2- torpedo vents fitted in after bridge bulkhead, and mushroom ventilator fitted on top of steel companion on bridge deck.

Hinged wood door fitted in opening in after bridge bulkhead as an emergency exit, this is in addition to the storm boards already in place.

Steel companion fitted on bridge deck aft of hatchway inside line of girder on this deck, with solid teak hinged door operated from both sides and 20" sill.
