S. With reference to Liverpool first entry report No. 118687 on the steamer "BRITISH PROMISE", I may say it is concluded additional means are provided for circulating cooling water through the main engines, and that a spare lubricating oil pump is fitted, but I shall be obliged if you will let me have confirmation on these points.

I would also remark that a number of advice notes from Stewart's and Lloyd's show that certain of the pipes are of Bessemer steel and I shall, therefore, be glad to learn if any of the steam pipes are of this material.
