Nature of Survey

When due

This vessel was classed in March 1917, subject to the inner surface and the bottom plating which was coated with tar, sprinkled with cement and again coated with tar, being examined within six months from the completion of the vessel.

The case has been deferred from time to time, as the vessel was on Government service, but the Owners now state the vessel is still under Government requisition although they hope she will be returned to them very shortly.

It is submitted action might be deferred for a short time.
