Nature of Survey

When due

The vessel was classed in March last subject to the inner surface of the bottom plating which was coated with tar sprinkled with cement & again coated with tar being examined within 6 months from the completion of the vessel.

The Owners now state that at present they are unable to submit the vessel for the necessary examination as she is on important Government Service on the North Coast of Scotland, and they hope the Committee will defer the examination required until a suitable opportunity.

They point out the sister vessel, S.S. Cristo, has been examined after 6 months service, and the coating of the inner surface of the bottom found satisfactory. (Correct by Repair)

It is submitted action might be deferred for the present.
