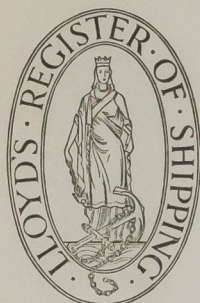

and that I will transmit to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a Report, stating that all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, also that I will Recommend that she be retained as classed with fresh record of D.S. 7,59, subject to deck plating in way of side tanker hatch (s.s.), after end of forecastle deck (s.s.), side shell plates F.4, C.3 & 5 (s.s.s.s.) and F.4 (p.s.f.) being examined and dealt with as necessary by next Special Survey.
