The class is subject to indented shell plates D.1, F.1, G.1,2,3,4 & 5, H.1,2,3 & 4, (p.s.) and D.1, F.1 & 2, G.1,2,4 & 5, H.1,2,3,4,5 & 6 J.2,4,10 & 12, K.9 & 10 (s.s.) also to soft nose stem plate being specially examined and dealt with as necessary next Special Survey.

ACTION is DEFERRED for examination in dry dock after grounding.

There is a S.R.L.Appendix Note.

The ship was laid up and the Notation "Laid Up Surveys Overdue 12,59" assigned 20.1.61 on expiry of the year of grace.

The LEITH Surveyors in a report dated 12.7.61 state that a General Examination has been held with a view to towing the ship to a Firth of Forth port from Methil for breaking up.

The case has been transmitted to London.

IT IS SUBMITTED ACTION be DEFERRED pending receipt of further information.
