The reports of survey held while this ship was in drydock at Piraeus last January have now received the consideration of the Committee. A record of Drydocking 1.60 and the notations port Screwshaft Examined 1.60 and Donkey Boiler Survey 1.60 have now been assigned.

The port main engine No.3 cylinder cover was examined in place and found to remain efficient, but it was recommended that a further examination should be held before the end of January, 1961, and the Committee have continued the class subject, *inter alia*, to this matter being dealt with by the time stated.
