Dear Sirs,

With reference to your Report No.13308 on the refrigerating machinery of the m.s."BLOEMFONTEIN", I have to request that you will state why you recommend a limiting temperature of 30°F in view of the fact that, according to the specification, it is intended to carry either chilled meat or bananas in the refrigerated cargo spaces.

You should also state the ice-melting capacity, as based on the Rule conditions.

Further, whether the meat rails are suspended from the beams, as proposed by the Builders on their plan No.2008, or in accordance with the alternative arrangements proposed by this Society and shown on that plan.

I may add that as it appears that two of the three sections of the ammonia evaporator are required to deal with the output of one compressor machine, the plant should be described as having one unit only.
