We regret to inform you that the above vessel went down near the breakwater of Keelung Harbor on March 31st, 1960. The cause of accident has not been officially determined. However, we understood that she hit the breakwater and damaged her No. 4 hold. The owner, Oriental Navigation Company has declared to abandon the vessel owing to salvage seeming impossible.

The vessel was renamed s.s. "EULLY" on March 12th 1960 in Yokohama where we took over from her formal owner and changed her nationality to Chinese.
