Messrs. Vancouver Iron Works, Limited, Vancouver, B.C., attend at their Plant for the purpose of examining during construction one steam drum and two water drums, intended for a Yarrow Water-tube Boiler to the order of Messrs. Foster Wheeler, Limited, St. Catherines, Ontario, and intended for a Frigate building for the Royal Canadian Navy.

The material has been tested by the Surveyors to Lloyd's Register; the scantlings are in accordance with the Society's Rules for a working pressure of 225 lbs. per square inch, and the workmanship is good. The welding has been carried out and tested in accordance with the Society's Rules for Class 1 Fusion Welded Pressure Vessels.

The three drums were tested by hydraulic pressure to 388 lbs. per square inch, showed no signs of weakness and were found tight and sound in every respect at that pressure.

These drums are being despatched to Canadian International Paper Co. Limited, Three Rivers, Quebec, for tubing and assembly and should be subjected to a further hydraulic test to the Rule pressure on completion of the installation.

This Certificate is issued upon the terms of the Rules and Regulations of the Society, which provide that:
