This ship, which sustained extensive fire damage while under repair at Amsterdam, has been sold to Jos de Smedt for breaking up at Antwerp, where demolition commenced 29th January, 1962.

SOURCE OF INFORMATION

ASLAUG TORM. — Amsterdam, Dec. 4. — Fire broke out this morning, apparently in the engine-room, on board Danish motor tanker Aslaug Torm. More than 40 firemen rushed to the dock. The fire was still burning early this afternoon.—British United Press.

Amsterdam, Dec. 4. — Motor tanker Aslaug Torm, repairing with Netherlands Dry Dock Company: It is reported fire originated in engine-room to-day and spread to cargo tanks. Fire brigade still fighting fire.

Amsterdam, Dec. 4. — Firefighters here opened outside valves in the Danish motor tanker Aslaug Torm to-day to combat an engine-room fire. Water rushed into the engine-room, helped to douse the flames, and flooded it to a depth of 10 ft. No one was hurt during the blaze.—Reuter.

ASLAUG TORM. — Amsterdam, Dec. 5. — Motor tanker Aslaug Torm: Fire extinguished in evening of Dec. 4. According to yard, fire only raged in engine-room and did not spread to cargo tanks. (See issue of Dec. 5.)

ASLAUG TORM. — London, Jan. 16. — Information has been received that motor tanker Aslaug Torm, which sustained fire damage in engine-room at Amsterdam in December, has been sold to Belgian shipbreakers. (See issue of Dec. 6.)
