EXAMINATION AND REPAIRS AS PER RULE FOR Gen.Exam. for voyage to a Far East Port as an Unclassed Vessel and Docking Survey

S.R.L.Items

"Leakages in way of No.1 Hold(ps)" cement box removed and doubling plate fitted externally in way of stringer leakage. A similar repair has been effected now to the stbd. stringer bar. It is recommended that this item be now deleted as a condition of class.
"Stringer plate, bulwark plating etc." specially examined and remains efficient.
It is recommended that this item be dealt with at next Special Survey.

S.R.L.Appendix examined and remain efficient, no repairs effected at this time.

The above items were examined and found satisfactory in my opinion for the General Examination for voyage to a Far East Port as an Unclassed Vessel.

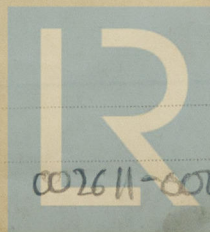
