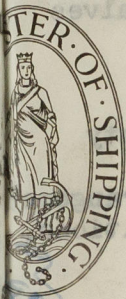

my satisfaction.*

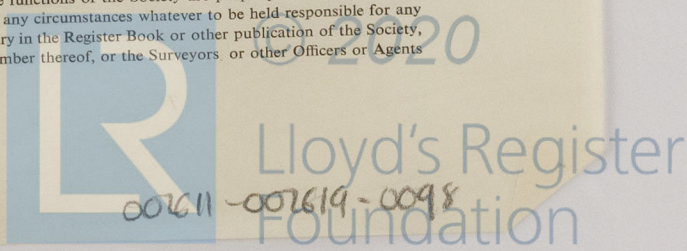

Electrical Survey complete.  
Port and stbd. main boilers and centre aux. boiler (safety  
valves of all boilers adjusted).  
Steering machinery, windlass and Fire Extinguishing Arrangements  
Main engines and auxiliaries tested under working conditions.

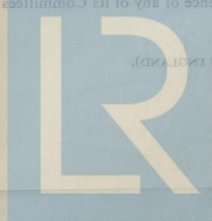
