This ship is classed BS\*.

The notation "Surveys Overdue" is recorded in the Register Book.

The class is subject to set in shell plating E.6 & 7, F.6 & G.6 (s.s.) being specially examined and dealt with as necessary by next Special Survey.

ACTION is DEFERRED for Special Survey.

A Special Survey TYPE 4 became due 8,52.

The PIRAEUS Surveyor reports, 10,53, this ship examined in drydock and the requirements of Special Survey TYPE 4 complied with.

Wear and tear repairs have been effected to shell plating, tank top plating and deck plating, etc. and permanent repairs effected to the subject item as above.

The ship has now been converted to oil fuel burning at this time, the cross bunker having been converted into an oil fuel deep tank in accordance with attached approved plan.

IT IS SUBMITTED the record of docking 10,53 and notations of "ss.Pir.10,53" and "A.S. 10,53" be assigned, without special condition.

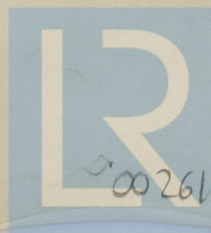
