I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 5th instant, the contents of which have been noted, and have pleasure in informing you that so far as classification with this Society is concerned, there will be no objection to the vessels proceeding to a Mediterranean Port as contemplated. If, however, you desire Interim Certificates for these voyages, it will be necessary for the ships to be submitted to inspection by the Society's Surveyors for this purpose.

I would point out, however, that the Annual Freeboard Survey of the Steamer "GEORGE BALFOUR" became due on the 8th April last, and the Annual Freeboard Survey of the Steamer "TYNDALL" on the 2nd April last. As required by the Ministry of Transport regulations, these surveys should be held by the 8th and 2nd July respectively and, no doubt, you will make arrangements for the surveys to be carried out by these dates.
