The torsional vibration characteristics of the main propelling machinery were approved in Secretary's letter of 14.12.50 for a service speed of 103 R.P.M. provided a notice board be fitted at the control station stating that the engine must not be run continuously between 47 and 56 R.P.M. The Machinery Certificate should be endorsed accordingly and a suitable entry made in the S.R.L.
