Dear Mr. Scott,

I have received your letter of the 15th ultimo, respecting the **S.S. "DALIA"**, but have not yet had an opportunity of examining the vessel in dry-dock.

The vessel arrived here at the beginning of May, but was in harbour for 4 days only, and the arrangements for docking were cancelled.

I would have informed you of this sooner, but there was a suggestion that the vessel might be docked at a port in the Far East or Australia, and I have waited until I could get some definite information as to this.

I am informed that the question is not yet decided, but it is considered that the most likely course is for the vessel to be docked on her return to Durban early in September.

As soon as I receive any further information, I will at once advise you.
