Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in

Temporary Alterations for troop carrying:-

Hatch coaming, 3' 8" x 4' 3", port side, after deck, removed and a  $\frac{5}{8}$ " riveted plate fitted over hatchway.

Troops' Galley, 12' 6" x 8' 0", built of  $\frac{1}{2}$ " steel plate and angles, in way of above mentioned hatchway and adjacent to Crews' bathroom.

1 set of Wellin Life Boat Davits fitted on Port Side, in way of after end No. 4 Hatchway.

1 set of Welling Lifeboat Davits fitted on Starb'd side in way of after end of No. 4 hatchway.

1 Wooden wash room 27' long erected on after deck, port side, and 1 wooden lavatory 27' long erected on starb'd side after deck. Flush pipes led over gunwale bar.

Forward end of No. 4 'tween deck a wooden bulkhead fitted, held in place by angles tack welded to deck and deck head.

Portable wooden scuttles fitted at Nos. 4 and 5 hatchways. Wood gratings fitted instead of usual hatch covers.
