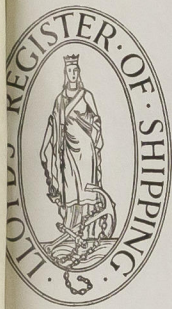

being fit to carry her usual cargoes.

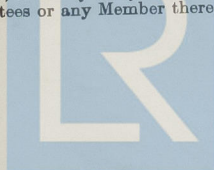
